WELCOME BACK, TIMORASSO

A historic grape variety from Lower Piedmont, Timorasso traces its roots back to the 14th century. After a long period of abandonment caused by phylloxera and the pursuit of more productive varieties, it nearly disappeared. Only thanks to the passion and vision of a few producers did it return to prominence in the 1980s, reclaiming its place on these hills. Timorasso is distinguished by its remarkable vertical structure, hinting at its predisposition for aging. This comparison between two vintages allows us to verify its actual longevity.

HEROIC AND SALTY

Heroic viticulture is born in territories where conditions are extreme, and vine cultivation becomes a real challenge. Here, driven by passion and awareness, producers dedicate their efforts to vineyards that demand sacrifice and commitment: steep slopes, high altitudes, and, as we will discover in this chapter, vineyards that overlook the sea. In these places, mechanization is almost impossible, and everything depends on human skill and tenacity. These are wines shaped by the sea breeze, capable of transporting the senses to coastal landscapes of rare beauty.

Furmint is a white grape variety originating from the Tokaji-Hegyalja region in Hungary, historically renowned for its central role in the production of great botrytized sweet wines. In recent years, however, Furmint has also been rediscovered in its dry version, revealing a new expressiveness. From vineyards situated at high altitudes, on volcanic soils, wines of great structure are now born, with vibrant acidity and persistent minerality. Among the protagonists of this renewal stands out Istvan Szepsy: his name, already indelibly linked to the history of the region, is now a symbol of a generation of producers capable of looking to the future without forgetting tradition.

MONTEROTONDO

Cortese is an ancient native Piedmontese grape variety, documented as far back as the 13th century. It is in the province of Alessandria where it finds its ideal territory, in the Gavi DOCG area, a historic denomination recognized as early as 1974.

Villa Sparina, through the Monterotondo vineyard, is committed to seek the maximum expression of this variety, creating a wine that perfectly embodies the character and tradition of this corner of Piedmont.

MADAME CLICQUOT

Barbe Nicole Clicquot Ponsardin, the daughter of a textile industrialist from Reims, was born in 1777. A creative spirit and tireless innovator, she marked the history of Champagne with a series of insights that would become true milestones: the first vintage champagne, the invention of the riddling table, and the first rosé obtained through blending. Thanks to these revolutions, she laid the foundations of modern Champagne production, turning her name into a symbol of excellence.

THE GOLDEN ISLAND

Porto Santo, the oldest island in the Portuguese archipelago, was discovered by Zarco in 1418 and was once famous for its fine grapes. Today, of those lush vineyards, less than 14 hectares remain, cultivated with passion by a few local farmers known as “Prophets.” On these calcareous soils in the north of the island, Crosta Calcária dos Profetas is born, a unique wine produced by the Companhia de Vinhos dos Profetas e dos Villões, founded by Nuno Faria and António Maçanita. The vines, aged between 40 and 80 years, are tended using traditional methods that protect them from strong winds while still allowing the sea breeze to pass through, imparting extraordinary salinity to the wine. Despite a limited production of about 900 bottles a year, Crosta Calcária is already considered one of the best wines in Portugal, becoming a true symbol of the history and identity of Porto Santo.

MONTESTEFANO

Since the 1970s, this cru has been among the most sought-after, with its first single-varietal vinification dating back to 1974. Montestefano covers an area of about 10 hectares. Its uniqueness stems from the composition of its soil, characterized by clay, tuff, and calcareous marl, present at just one meter of depth. This soil, particularly rich in minerals, provides the vines with essential nutrients, allowing the formation of clusters with thicker skins and seeds compared to the average.

It is precisely this characteristic that gives the wine greater structure, so much so that it is often described as tending to “barolize,” acquiring complexity and longevity comparable to those of Barolo.

THE SOLDERA ECOSYSTEM

The story of Soldera Case Basse began in the 1970s when the Soldera family settled on the southwest slope of Montalcino, transforming the abandoned Case Basse estate into a unique place.

On 23 hectares, Sangiovese vineyards, woods, and an extraordinary collection of ancient flowers and fruits alternate, creating a true natural oasis and a source of inspiration for scholars and enthusiasts.

In the cellar, precision and care are absolute: every step, from harvesting to bottling, is followed with almost obsessive attention. Nothing is left to chance. Every sip of this wine is a tribute to the intuition and courage of those who knew how to turn their passion into a true work of art.

EARTH, FIRE, AND PASSION

A mountainous climate in the heart of a Mediterranean island, on volcanic soils: Etna is a mountain that breaks traditional patterns, giving its wines a unique identity. Here, man is still a guest of nature, called to respect its rhythms and essence.

In recent years, a new generation of producers has been able to interpret this extraordinary territory, creating elegant, tense wines that are deeply connected to the land. The soil composition, the result of successive lava flows, contributes to a surprising variety of terroirs, but the most marked difference lies in the altitudes: the SS120 marks the boundary between the lower districts, around 600 meters, and the vineyards that reach the edge of the appellation, at 850 meters above sea level.

Considered a symbol of the Barbaresco village, the Asili vineyard holds a prominent place in the area's winemaking history. Here, at the top of the hill, the Ceretto family owns a tiny parcel with varied exposure and limited yield. For the family, it carries deep symbolic value, as it was the first piece of a vineyard estate begun in the early 1970s.

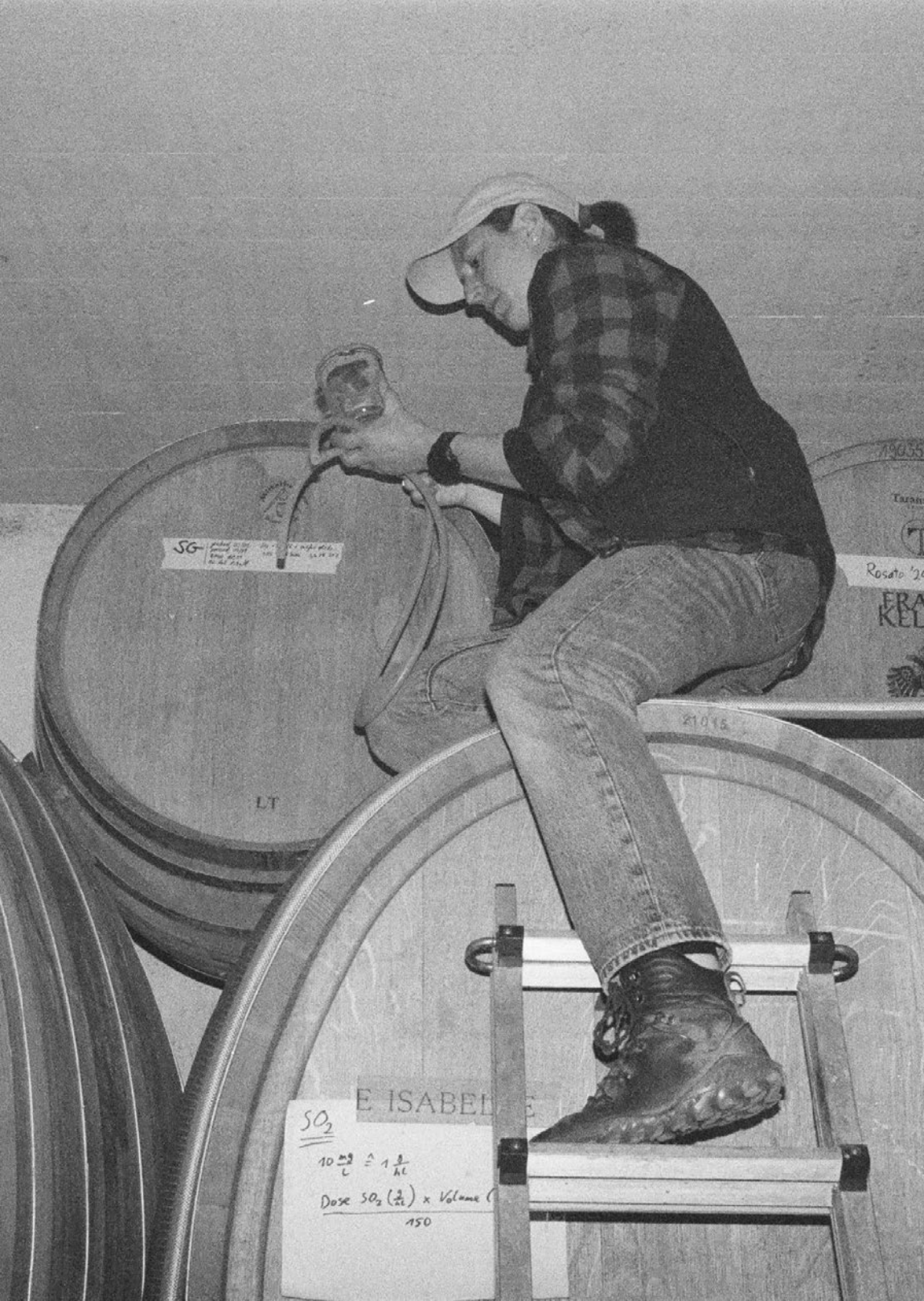

MONPRIVATO

Monprivato, in Castiglione Falletto, is a name that embodies the history and soul of Barolo. Here, the Mascarello family has been preserving one of the most famous vineyards in the area since 1904, choosing since 1970 to vinify it as a single-varietal to enhance its unique character.

As early as the 1980s, the great Renato Ratti recognized it as one of the most important crus in all of Langa.

Monprivato tells the story of this territory better than many others: we present it in three great vintages, to discover together all its nuances.

CANNUBI SAN LORENZO

Cannubi–San Lorenzo is the highest section of the Cannubi hill. From a parcel of just 0.2 hectares, facing east/southeast, the Ceretto family tends over 90-year-old vines using ancestral methods and no mechanical assistance.

These old vines yield a small quantity of precious grapes, traditionally vinified and aged for ten years in magnum format.

“Technically, Cannubi came before Barolo—so engaging with history inevitably means passing through these very rows. At the beginning of the 2000s, acquiring a slice of this hill felt like a natural step, allowing us to enter into a unique dialogue with the roots of this land.”

NORDIC SOUL AND SOUTHERN HEART

From the Swiss Alps to the shores of the Mediterranean, the Rhône Valley spans diverse territories and is traditionally divided into two areas: the Northern Rhône and the Southern Rhône. This region is renowned for its red wines: pure Syrah in the north and refined blends of Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre in the south.

What makes the Vallée du Rhône unique is also its millenary history: more than two thousand years ago, the Romans planted the first vineyards here, laying the foundations for a tradition that is now reflected in some of the most prestigious appellations in the world.
